Grant of Probate – is a document issued by the Supreme Court. It confirms that a will is valid and gives the executors the authority to act. Estates with Police Credit Union Accounts and aggregated balances more than \$15,000 require probate.

Letters of Administration – are documents granted by the Supreme Court, giving authority to an administrator to collect and distribute the assets of the estate, in the absence of a valid Will. Estates with Police Credit Union Accounts and aggregated balances more than \$15,000 require Letters of Administration.
